## THE GAME

Concept: A chess game, whereby only pawns are used.
Number of Players: 4 (maximum)
Number of Judges: 1(minimum)
Roles of a Judge:
$\checkmark$ Draw out question from the Q\&A deck \& reads them to the player.
$\checkmark$ Gives points accordingly as stated on the card.
$\checkmark$ Table out the player's earning and/or dismissal of points.
$\checkmark$ Make sure there're no miscellaneous happenings throughout the game.

## How to Play:

i. 4 players are placed at each side of the board.
ii. 8 pawns are given to each players; i.e.: 32 pawns in total. (all 4 sets of pawns are physically different)
iii. Players will roll dice to determine which player goes first, second and so on.
iv. After all is set, the game starts with 3 rounds, whereby the level of questions assigned are to be randomly set and given by the judge.
v. After the $3^{\text {rd }}$ round (the $4^{\text {th }}$ one), questions are given in order according to the *question level distribution.
vi. Process is repeated.

## Rules to follow

## Pawn:

- Has a normal chess pawn move and ability. I.e.: moves vertically forward \& diagonally to eat an opponent.
- In the first round, only pawns from position b-g is allowed to move.
- Able to eat King.
- Number of steps to be taken is dependent on the level of *difficulty of a question.
- No pawns can move backwards.

King:

- A king can only move if the player is able to answer a level 6 question.
- A king can only kill a pawn or another king at a time.
- A king can move in all directions.
- Luck \& Chance Draw is not applicable on King.
- To be King, a pawn has to reach the direct opposite end line of his/her opponent.


## THE CHALLENGE

*Question Level Distribution:

- 6 levels in total
- Difficulty of questions increases as the level increases.
- Level of difficulty affects the number of moves a player can make and the **number of points awarded.

| LEVEL | STEP/S |
| :---: | :---: |
| $1,2,3$ | 1 |
| 4,5 | 2 |
| 6 | 3 |

How to Win:

- Player has to have at least a King, and gets the highest points.
**Points:
- Points awarded is dependent on the level of difficulty of the questions, promotion of pawn to King, and the last player who is still standing (20 points).

| LEVEL | POINTS |
| :--- | :--- |
| 1 | 1 |
| 2 | 2 |
| 3 | 3 |
| 4 | 4 |
| 5 | 5 |
| 6 | 6 |

Penalty:

- Points will not be given if question is answered wrongly.
- Skip turn if question answered wrongly.


## THE FUN

Luck \& Chance Draw: 12 different cards randomly arranged into a deck.
